
Subj : Compliance of Recommendations for Business Reform Action Plan (BRAP) 2019.

Sir,

With reference to above, and in respect of Point No. 49 (i) of Business Reform Action Plan 2019, which recommends that the State Government "ensure that the State Regulator publishes monthly data, regarding total duration and frequency of power outages online in public domain", this is to inform that the present demand-supply economics of the state of Mizoram does not justify the acquisition and operationalisation of Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system in a state-wide manner which will involve investment of huge amount, beyond the economic bearing of the state.

In view of above, and the power demand of Mizoram being very minimal compared to other states, (Peak demand is about 110 MW, and Off-peak demand is around 50 MW only); Implementation of this point may be given to State Regulator's discretion based on information furnished by Power & Electricity Department to the Regulator.
